Colvill and Capt. Hyland.

Mr. Calder brings in a Bill entitled, *An Act to enable Samuel Wilson, Executor of Margaret Lindow, to convey certain Lands to David Wilson*; which was Read the First Time, and ordered to lie on the Table.

The Bill entitled, *An Act for enlarging the Jurisdiction of the County-Courts*, was Read the Second Time with the Amendments, and passed, and sent to the Upper House by Mr. Stoughton and Capt. Harrison.

The Bill entitled, *An Act for building a Prison in Worcester County*, was sent to the Upper House by Col. Henry and Capt. Selby.

On reading a Paragraph in the Bill for dividing *Prince George's County*, which relates to the placing a Court-House; the Question was put, Whether there should be any Alteration in that Part of the Bill, which mentions a Place for building a Court-House on? *Resolved* that there be an Alteration.

On reading a Second Time the Bill entitled, *An Act to divide Prince George's County, and to erect a new County on the upper Part thereof*; the Question was put, Whether the said Bill shall pass, or not? *Resolved* in the Affirmative.
