

*An Act to impower and direct the Clerk of Charles County to enter and record among the said County Records, a Deed of Bargain and Sale from James Connell and Anne his Wife, to John Dunbar, of a parcel of Land therein mentioned.*

*A supplementary and additional Act to the Act, entituled, An Act for erecting a Town on the North side of Patapsco in Baltimore County, and for laying out in Lots Sixty Acres of Land in and about the Place where John Fleming now lives; and to an Act, entituled, An Act for erecting a Town on a Creek divided on the East from the Town lately laid out in Baltimore County, called Baltimore Town, on the Land whereon Edward Fell keeps Store.*

*An Act to enable the Commissary-General to enter and record, amongst the Records of his Office, the last Will and Testament of Henry Staples, deceased, for the Purposes therein mentioned.*

*An Act for Settlement of Lands therein mentioned on Francis Waring, and the Heirs of his Body lawfully begotten.*

*An Act to direct and impower the Clerk of Prince George's County to enter and record among the Records of the said County, a Deed of Bargain and Sale from John Nevill, William Collier, and Thomas Bond, to John Boyd, of a Tract of Land therein mentioned.*

*An Act for ascertaining the Allowance of Petit Jurors attending the Provincial Court, and to limit Costs with respect to Evidences.*

*An Act for laying out one Acre of Land convenient to Rock-Creek Landing, on Potomack River, on the Land George Gordon now lives on, and for Building a rolling Houle thereon.*

*An Act for the Gauge of Barrels for Pork, Beef, Pitch, Tar, Turpentine, and tare of Barrels for Flour or Bread.*

The following Ingrossed Bills were likewise Presented to his Excellency, but were laid by, as thereof he would be advised.

*An Ingrossed Bill, entituled, An Act for laying an Imposition on Tobacco, and other Commodities therein mentioned, for the Discharge of his Lordship's Quit-Rents, and Support of Government.*

*An Ingrossed Bill, entituled, An Act for the Trial of all Matters of Fact in the several Counties where they have arisen or shall arise.*

*An Ingrossed Bill, entituled, An Act for the Limitation of Officers Fees.*

*An Ingrossed Bill, entituled, An Act to divide Dorchester and Queen-Anne's Counties, and to erect a new County out of the upper Parts thereof by the Name of Prince William County. And*

*An Ingrossed Bill, entituled, An Act to divide Prince George's County, and to erect a new one by the Name of Frederick County.*

His Excellency then made a Speech to the Members of the Lower House of Assembly, and Dissolved them.
