Nasmuch as you have offered an high Indignity to this House in a public Manner, and particularly to a Member thereof. in the Execution of bis Duty; you are to ask Pardon of the House, and that Member; and at the same Time take Notice, that the Consideration of your Age and Character, and that what you did is looked upon to be done thro' Inadvertency, hath induced the House to use you with great Indusgence.

Mr. Snowden made his due Submission to the House, and to the Member in Whereupon, he was discharged on Payment of the Fees to the Serparticular. jeant at Arms.
