

We also find a Deed of Gift from *Mary Stevenson*, of *Baltimore County*, to *Elizabeth Barney*, her Heirs, and Assigns, dated the 16th Day of *January*, 1717, for the same Land, and acknowledged the same Day before the same two Justices, but not recorded. We likewise find a Receipt from the said *Morgan Murray*, to *William Barney*, in the Words following, viz. *June the 1 Day 1723 Receive of William Barney In ful of all Account Bills Bonds and Notes whatsoever hath bin past One Account of One Hundred and Fifty Akers of Land I say Receive per me*

We further find the Deposition of *Henry Satyr*, taken the 6th of *June*, 1747, before *Samuel Owings*, one of the Justices of *Baltimore County*, wherein he makes Oath, That to the best of his Know edge, a certain Tract of Land, called *Morgan's Delight*, which was conveyed to *Mary Stevenson* and *Elizabeth Barney*, and her Heirs, was fully paid for; and knows of no further Demand being made for the said Land, these twenty Years, or more. All which is most humbly submitted to the Consideration of your Honourable House.

On motion of a Member, for Leave to bring in a Supplementary Bill to the Act for laying out the Town anew, commonly called *Snow-Hill Town*, in *Somerset County*; Leave is given: Ordered, That *Col. Hooper*, *Col. Scarborough*, and *Col. Henry*, prepare and bring in a Bill accordingly.

Ordered, That the Serjeant at Arms do summon *Mr. William Thornton*, Sheriff of *Anne Arundel County*, to attend at the Bar of this House, to answer the Complaint of *Francis Wolf*, a Prisoner in his Custody, for levere and rigorous Usage.

On motion of a Member, that Leave be given to bring in a Bill to prevent the raising of Swine and Geese in *Princess Anne Town*, in *Somerset County*; Leave is given.

Mr. Hammond, from the Committee of Laws, delivers to *Mr. Speaker* an Address to the Governor; which was read, approved, and ordered to be ingrossed.

Col. Hooper, from the Committee of Laws, delivers to *Mr. Speaker* an Address to the Governor; which was read, approved, and ordered to be ingrossed.
