Which Bills were feverally read here, and passed for Ingrossing.

The Bill, entituled An Act to prevent Evils arising from the entering up Judgments upon Bonds, commonly called Judgment Bonds, &c. was read, with the Amendments proposed by the Upper House, and passed to lingrossing.

Col. Tasker, from the Upper House, delivers to Mr. Speaker the Bill, entituled An Ast for raising Three Pence Sterling per Hogshead, &c. Indors'd,

By the Upper House of Assembly, July 8, 1747. Read the second Time, and will pass, with the following Amendments: After the Word raised, in the 14th Line of the 1st Page, to the Word Province, in 6th Line of 3d Page, to be lest out, and the following Clauses to be inserted: Which said Duty shall be aisposed of for the purch chasses, in the maintaining a Magazine for the better Defence of this Province, and for the due Preservation thereof, and paid to the Ireasurer or Treasurers of this Province, for the Time being, who shall be allowed Two Pounds Ten Shillings per Cent. for the Receipt and Payment thereof; and to be disposed of to the Uses afore fail, as the Governor and Council for the time being, shall direct: For the Collection whereof, the Nawal Officers shall be allowed Eight Pounds per cent. and no more. And he is further Enasted by the Authority aforeshid, I hat the several and respective Treasurers shall from time to time make and render to toth Houses of Assembly of this Province, sufficient and clear Accounts of what Money they shall receive by Virtue of this Ast, and how the same shall have been disposed of. Anabe is likewise Enasted, That the soverely shall receive in Virtue of this Ast, and they are berely directed to transmit all the Bills of Exchange or Monies which they shall receive in Virtue of this Ast, to Mr. Joseph Adams, Merchant in London, to be by him kept and paid out, according to the Directions, and to the Uses in this Ast mentioned. Leave out the two Provisoes, Pages 3 and 4. Instead of the Words, their several and respective Salaries or Allowances, in the 10th and 11th Lines of the 4th Page, put these Words, Eighty Pounds yearly. In the 12th Line of the same Page, after the Word otherwish, to the End of the Bill, to be lest out, and the solowing Clause to be added: This Act to continue until the 29th Day of September, which shall be in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty, and no longer.

On reading the Alterations proposed by the Upper House to the said Bill, the Question was put, Whether this House agrees that the Money to be sailed by the Bill, entituled An Ast for raising Three Peace Sterling. &c. shall be paid to the Treasurers of this Province, as proposed by the Upper House, or not? Resolved in the Affirmative.
