By the Lower House of Assembly, May 14, 1748.

May it please your Honours,

**I**T appearing to this House, that frequent Disputes arise between the Inhabitants of *Prince George's* and *Baltimore* Counties; as also between those of *Dorchester* and *Worcester* Counties; which create considerable Losses to the Public, by Concealment of Taxables, and other Evils, for Want of the Divisions between the aforeaid Counties being ascertained, in order to prevent which, we propose that Major *Thomas Sberedine*, Mr. *Thomas Franklin*, and Mr. *Daniel Rawlings*, Mr. *Nathanael Wickham*, junior, Mr. *Thomas Beattys*, Capt. *Joseph Ogle*, and Capt. *John Dorsey*, be Commissioners for *Baltimore* and *Prince George's* Counties; and Capt. *Bartholomew Ernalls*, Mr. *Daniel Sullivan*, Mr. *Isaac Nichols*, Col. *John Henry*, Col. *John Scarborough*, Mr. *Benjamin Handy*, and Col. *George Dashtel*, Commissioners for *Dorchester* and *Worcester* Counties; to run certain Lines, or ascertain such Metes and Bounds, as to them or the major Part of them shall seem most convenient, for dividing the said Counties; and to make Report thereof to the next General Assembly; to be confirmed by an Act to that Purpose, if found agreeable to the several Branches of the Legislature; to which we desire the Concurrence of your House.
