complain of the Order of Court aforesaid; and for sundry other Reasons in the said Remon-strance mentioned, as in and by the said Remonstrance, lodged in the Honourable House, will more fully appear. But some Time after this, the said Commissioners did contract to repair, or rather rebuild and enlarge, the said Court House; and that the same has been some Time since actually begun: All which Transactions have been carried on, under the colour of an Act of Assembly of this Province entituled, An Act to enable the Commissioners of County Courts to long Tobacce, to destray the Charges of their respective Counties; which Law, we humbly conceive, gives no such Powers, or warrants any such Proceedings.
