

Your Committee further observe, that the Clerk of *Prince George's* County Court has not returned a List of the Ordinary Licenses granted in that County in the Year 1748; and that the Clerks of *Cecil* and *Charles* Counties have not returned Lists of the Ordinary Licenses granted in their Counties in the Year 1749: For Want of which Lists, we cannot ascertain the Sums due from the Sheriffs of said Counties on Account of Ordinary Licenses aforesaid, in those Years.

Your Committee find by the Books of the Paper Currency Office, that the Commissioners of the said Office have paid the Justices of the several Counties, and Commissioners of *Charles-Town*, the following Sums, on Account of the Act for amending the Staple of Tobacco, &c. viz.
