In the same Page, Line 5, leave out the Proviso, be-" ginning at the Word and, to the Word Inspector in Line 8, and insert " the following; Provided nevertbeless, that notwithstanding one Inspec-" tor shall only act as aforesaid, yet that both the Inspectors and their " Bonds shall be liable in the same Manner as if both Inspectors had afted. " In the same Page, Line 17, after the Word officiated, to the Word Of-" fence in the 8th Line of the 3d Page, to be left out. In Page 5, Line 4, " after the Word same, to the Word not with flanding in the 3d Line of the " 6th Page, to be lest out. In the 6th Line of the 6th Page, between " Not with flanding and And, insert the following Words, And which said " Inspettur,
