Which several Duties, Impositions, and Taxes, amounting per Annum to the Sum of 7953 l. will, in Five Years, clear of Commission for Collection, nett 37,775 l. and as the several Duties, Impositions, and Licences, mentil ned in an Act of Assembly entituled, An Act for his Majesty's Service, made at a Session of Aniembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis the 17th Day of July, 1754, will, we presume, be disengued in about Three Years Time, 'tis proposed that the Duties, &c. in that Act be continued from and after the several Purposes of the said Act, and the Acts therein mentioned, be fully answered, compleated, and fulfilled, until the Forty Thousand Pounds, by the Ways and Means aforesaid, and by the Continuance of that Act, be repaid, replaced, and sunk, and until the End of the next Session of Assembly that shall thereafter happen.
