And he it further Enacted, That every Person or Persons who shall, from and after the Twenty-ninth D. vos Some for next ensuing, keep any Public or Private School, or Seminary, or teach and instruct any Y with as Tutor or School-master, within this Province, without having first taken the Oaths to the Government, and subscribing the Test and Oath of Abjuration, before some Provincial or County Magistrate, and side having obtained a Licence from the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, and shall a very become an information, Presentment, or Indistment, in any of his Lordship's Courts of the variation this Province, or before Judices of Oyer and Terminer, shall and may be committed to the Changes Goal of such Change Months, to commence from the Time that such Person or Persons shall be received into the stud Goal. And we it further Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That any Person who shall have obtained a Licence, and taken and his bribed the Oaths and Test above appointed, and shall at any Time after, during the consense in the season and Public or Private School, or Seminary, or instructing any Youth as Tutor consense in the knowingly or willingly resort to, or be present at, any Conventicle, Assembly, or Meet-13. In the installe of Religion, although the Liturgy be there used, where his Majesty King George where there may en for in express Words, except where such particular Offices of the Liturgy are used, where there are the express Directions to pray for his Majesty and the Royal Family, shall be liable to the Possible in this Act, and shall from thenceforth be incapable of keeping any Public or Private School, or Schilbary of Learning, or indructing any Youth as Tutor or School-master. Provided always, That this Act or my Plang therein contained, shall not extend, or be construed to extend, to any Tutor who shall be emi oged in the Family of any Roman Catholic within this Province, to teach such Children only as are descended from Roman Catholic Parents, or to deprive any Protestant Dissenter or Dissenters whatsoever 110 m the Denesits and Advantages they enjoy, by the Toleration and Ease granted to such Dissenters by an Diver Parliament, made in the first Year of the Reign of King William and Queen Mary, entituled, As Act for exempting their Mejesties Protestant Subjects, dissenting from the Church of England, from the Penalties of certain Laws; any Thing herein contained to the contrary thereof, in any wife, notwithstanding. Pravided nie, and be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That if any Person, who shall has a been convicted as aforefuld, and thereby made incapable to teach or instruct any Youth as aforesaid, fall, after such Conviction, conform to the Church for the Space of One Year, without having been present at any Conventicle, Asiembly, or Meeting, as aforefaid (except as before excepted), and receive the Sacra-Ment of the Lord Supper, according to the Rites and Usage of the Church of England, at least three Times n that Year, every fach Person or Persons shall be again capable of having and using a Licence to teach School, or to indirect Youth as a Tutor or School-master, he or they also performing all that is made requi-Lite thereunt ) by this Act.

And be it further Enacted, That if any Popish Priest or Jesuit shall hereaster, by any Ways or Means whattoever, put in practice, ergoge, seduce, persuade, convert, and withdraw, or attempt or endeavour to engage, seduce, or persuade, convert, and withdraw, any of his Majesty's Subjects within this Province from their natural Obedience to his Majesty, and from the Religion now by Law established within his Majesty's Dom means, to the Romish Religion, or to move them, or any of them, to promise any Obedience to any pretended Authority of the See of Rome, or of any other Prince, State, or Potentate, to be had or and within his Majesty's Dominions, or shall do any overt Act to that Intent or Purpose, and every of them shall be, to all Intents and Purposes, adjudged to be a Traytor or Traytors, and being thereof lawfully constited, shall have Judgment, suffer and forfeit, as in Case of High-Treason. And if any Person, now began Proteitiont, or the Age of Eighteen Years, or upwards, shall, after the End of this Session of Assembly, by any Means be willingly absolved, or withdrawn, as aforesaid, or willingly be reconciled, or shall then every such Person, their Procurers and Counsellors thereunto, being thereof lawfully convicted, shall be taken, used, and adjudged, and shall suffer and forfeit as in Case of High-Treason.
