larly to order and direct how much thereof shall be levied and collected by the Sheriff of each respective County, and to what Person or Persons the said Sheriffs shall pay the same; and after the same is so assessed and apportioned, the faid Committee shall forthwith deliver to the Sheriff of Anne-Arundel County, a fair List or Account thereof for each County, indorsed for his Lordship's Service, and directed to the Sheriffs of the several Counties respectively, who are hereby obliged to demand, collect, levy and pay, the several Sums of Tobacco therein mentioned, by Way of Execution, in the same Manner that County Levies are usually by Law to be demanded, collected, levied and paid; and shall pay the same to the several Persons

Privided airceys, and be it Enasted, That the faid Committee shall, in every such List, direct and appoint that the Allowances to the faid Delegates shall be levied and paid to each Delegate in the County where he rendes, and not elsewhere, unless the Amount of the Sum to be levied on the several Taxables in any County should not be sufficient for that Purpose; in which Case the said Committee shall direct that the-Delegates for such County shall be paid the Remainder of their Allowance in some one of the adjacent Counties.

Prevines access, and be it further Enacted, That from and after the End of this Session of Assembly, for and during the Term and Time of Four Years, all such Councillors who shall serve in the General Assembly, and also all such Provincial Magistrates, who are or shall be Inhabitants and Residents of the City of Annapolis, or whose Habitations are so near the said City that they shall usually, in Assembly or Provincial Court Time, lodge at Home, shall be allowed only one Half the Sum that others are to be allowed under this Act.]
