Your Committee find, That no Money hath been paid into the Office in Virtue of the Act for Encouragement of able bodied Freemen, woluntarily Enlisting in his Majesty's Serwice, for the Expedition against Cuba, fince the Report in April Session, 1757; so that a Ballance of 684 l. 14s. 6 d. still remains due to the Office for Money taken out by that Act, which was to have been replaced by Public Assessment.
