that such Man was able-bodied, and fit for the Service aforesaid, and has past Muster at some Place, and before some Person, for that Purpose appointed, nor shall they allow more than at the Rate of Eight Pounds per Man, for the whole Number of Men to be Enlisted by any one Person to be commissioned as aforesaid, and Twenty Shillings per Man, to such Person as a Re-

ward for Enlifting the faid Men.

XXVIII. A N D whereas by other Letters from the Right Honourable the Earl of Egremont, and Sir Jeffery Amherst, his Majesty's Pleasure has been signified, that this Province should furnish Levy-Money for raising Eighty-four effective Men, for compleating the Regular Corps serving in America; being therefore desirous to comply with this Royal Requisition, it is humbly prayed that it may be Enacted; And be it Enacted by the Authority, Advice, and Consent aforesaid, That a Sum not exceeding Seven Hundred and Fifty-six Pounds, shall be, and is hereby appropriated to the Raising Eighty-four effective Men, for the Purpose asoresaid, and the Commissioners or Trustees asoresaid, are hereby required to deliver out the said Sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Persons herein appointed to call for and receive the same.

XXIX. A N D in Order to encourage good and effective Men to enter into the Service aforesaid, Be it further Enacted, That there shall be paid to each able-bodied Man, not under the Age of Eighteen, nor above the Age of Forty Years, who shall be received by the Officer, or Person, who shall be properly authorised to receive the Men asoresaid, the Sum of Eight Pounds Current Money, over and above the Encouragement given by his Majesty. And the better to enable and encourage the Officers who may be employed in Enlisting the said Men, to be expeditious in doing their Duty, there shall be allowed to each Officer, who may be authorised for that Purpose, the Sum of Twenty Shillings for each Man, able-bodied, and of the

Age aforesaid, which he shall Enlist.

XXX. AND be it further Enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Governor and Commander in Chief of this Province, for the Time being, to issue Commissions for raising the said Eighty-tour Men, and the Agents aforesaid, are hereby impowered and required to draw out of the Office aforesaid, the said Sum of Seven Hundred and Fisty-six Pounds, and deliver out the same, to be expended, to the Officers who shall be appointed to levy and raise the said Men; and the said Money shall be by the said Officers disposed of, and accounted for, and the Remain ler thereof, if any there should be in the Hands of the said Agents or Officers, shall be disposed of, and the Whole accounted for by the f.id Agents, in like Manner, on the like Conditions, by the same Times, and under the like Penalties, as is directed, required,
