At the above Meeting, one Justice and one Representative to be appointed, to cause to be surveyed and laid out, one Acre of Land at Emerson's Warehouse in Taibot County, for the Use of the

Public, none being yet laid out.

Inspectors not to deliver Crop Notes or Receipts for Transfer, unless they have the Hogsheads actually ready to be delivered, for which they deliver such Notes, under Penalty of Five Pounds for every Note or Receipt so delivered.

That there be a Penalty of one Hundred Pounds upon each Inspector, in Case of an Inspection

House being burnt, where it can be made appear to be by the Neglect of such Inspector.
