the Use of the Assembly Office, and that Mr. *J. Hall* and Mr. *Johnson* do prepare and bring in the  
same.

An Ingrossed Bill, entitled, *An Act empowering Richard Richardson, of Frederick County, to sell and  
dispose of the Lands, &c.* was Read and Assented to, and sent to the Upper House, with the Paper  
Bill, by Mr. *Magruder* and Mr. *H. Baker*.

An Ingrossed Bill, entitled, *An Act imposing an additional Duty of £. 2 per Poll on all Negroes, &c.*  
was Read and Assented to, and sent to the Upper House, with the Paper Bill thereof, by Mr.  
*Thomas* and Mr. *William Adams*.

The Bill, entitled, *An Act for laying out and erecting a Town at Elk-Ridge Landing*, was Read the  
second Time, and will pass, and was sent to the Upper House by Mr. *Plater* and Mr. *Johnson*.
