10th Day of May, 1748.

An Act, entitled, An Act for the more effectual Punishment of Negroes and other Slaves, and for taking away the Benefit of Clergy from certain Offenders; and a Supplementary Act to an Act, entitled, An Act to prevent the Tumultuous Meetings and other Irregularities of Negroes and other Slaves, and directing the Manner of Trying Slaves; made at a Seffion of Affembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the 15th Day of May, 1751.

An Act, entitled, An Act to exempt Persons appearing at Musters, from Arrests in Civil Cases; made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the 10th Day of

An Act, entitled, An Act to make the Testimony of Convicted Persons legal against Convicted Persons; made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the 15th Day of May, 1751.

An Act, entitled, An Act relating to Guardians and Orphans; made at a Seffion of Affembly

begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the 28th Day of March, 1758.

An Act, continuing An Act, entitled, An Act for the Relief of fuck Persons as cannot find Surety for their Appearance, to testify as a Witness against any Person arrested, accused, or profecuted for any Criminal Matter; made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the 3d Day of June, 1752.

An Act, continuing an Act, entitled, An Act for the more effectual destroying of Squirrels and Crows, in the Counties of Kent, Queen-Anne's, and Talbot, and for destroying Red Fexes in the faid Counties; made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Assapolis, the

24th Day of May, 1749.

An Act for destroying Crows and Squirrels in particular Counties; made at a Session of Assem-

bly begun and held at the City, of Annapolis, the 22d November, 1758.

An Act for the speedy and effectual Publication of the Laws of this Province, and for the Encouragement of Jonas Green, of the City of Annapolis, Printer, expired the 2d Day of April, 1765. An Act to establish a Market at the Market-House in Chester-Town, in Kent County, and for the Regulation of the said Market, made in March Session, 1762.

An Act for the destroying of Squirrels and Crows in Baltimore County, made the same Time. An Act for giving a Bounty for taking Indian Prisoners, and other Purposes therein mentioned;

made in 1763.

An Act for prohibiting all Trade with the Indians, for the Time therein mentioned, expired the

1st Day of November, 1764.

An Act, entitled, An Act for repairing the Public Roads in this Province, made at a Session of Affembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the 2d Day of October, 1753; and the Supplementary Act thereto, made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapelis, the 23d Day of February, 1756. All which is humbly fubmitted to the Confideration of the Honourable House.
