Pursuant to an Order of the Honourable House of Representatives, of the 7th of December, the following BILL, which was then brought in to the House, and referred to the Consideration of next Session of Assembly, is here annexed, for the Perusal of the Inhahabitants of this Province, viz.

An ACT to enable the Proprietors of inspected Tobacco, to remove the same from the Inspecting Houses, to other Warehouses, convenient for the lading thereof on board Vessels for Exportation.

THEREAS Ships and Vessels are greatly delayed in load-Pressile. ing with Tobacco within this Province, occasioned by the Distance of Inspecting Houses from each other, and many of them being necessarily fixed for the Convenience of the Planters, on the Heads of Creeks and Rivers, where Vessels of any considerable Burther, cannot go, and even small Crast are often long detained from the Shallowness of the Water, and it being often ir practicable, for a Length of Time, to remove Tobacco by Reason of the Ice; all which Delays greatly discourage Trade, and the Expenses occationed thereby, fall ultimately on the Makers of Tubacco To Remedy therefore such Inconveniencies for the future, for the more safe keeping of Tobaccoes and Encouragement of Trade;

II. Be it Enaced, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, Warehouses on by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and Bay, to be apthe Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, inspected Tobacco.

on the Western Shore, and

on the Eastern Shore, be and are hereby appointed Places on and in which Warehouses may be built for the Reception, Storing, and safe Keeping of Tobacco, for Exportation, in Manner herein after mentioned.

III. And be it further Enaced, That any Person or Persons In what Mannet whatsoever, may at his, her, or their Will and Pleasure, and by Consent and Agreement between him, her or them, and the respective Proprietors of the Land, at the Places aforefail hereby affigned and appointed for creeting Warehouse, set up, erect. and build in and upon any of the Places aforesaid, good Framed Warehouses, each Warehouse being not less than Forty Feet in De-Length, and Twenty Feet in Breadth, covered with Shingles, and
