

County in which the same shall be, and be by them approved as sufficient, and a Certificate thereof signed by the said three Justices, entered on Record: And such Warehouses, Wharfs and Cranes, shall be so viewed and approved in the Month of November, yearly, and if any of them shall on any such View be deemed insufficient, such Warehouse shall not thenceforth, until the same be sufficiently repaired and approved of as aforesaid, have any Tobacco stored therein.

VI. And be it further Enacted, That no Person whatsoever, shall keep any Goods for Sale in any of the said Warehouses, but that they be wholly kept and appropriated to and for the Storing and Keeping of Hogsheads, Casks, and Cases of inspected Tobacco, for Exportation. To be appropriated to no other use.

VII. And be it further Enacted, That upon the Order or Request of any Proprietor of inspected Tobacco, which by the Laws now in Being may or can be exported, and delivering up the Inspectors Note therefor, the Inspector or Inspectors at any Inspecting House within this Province, shall and may deliver such Tobacco to such Proprietor or other Person by him appointed, to be safely and securely carried to any of the Warehouses to be erected in virtue of this Act, at any of the Places aforesaid, that shall be named by such Proprietor, either by Land or Water, if to the Warehouses, in the same Place or next adjacent to the Place where such Delivery shall be, or by Water if to any of the other Warehouses to be erected in virtue of this Act. And such Inspector or Inspectors, shall also at the Time of such Delivery of Tobacco, if the same is designed to be carried to any Warehouse, of which he or they hath or have not the Charge and Keeping, also deliver to the Person who is to carry such Tobacco, a fair List or Certificate, containing the Marks, Numbers, Gross, Tare, and Nett Weight of the Tobacco delivered, the Proprietor's Name, the Inspecting House, at which, the Name of the Person, to whom, the Time when delivered, and the Warehouse at which the same is designed to be delivered. Inspectors may deliver out inspected Tobacco to the Proprietor; with a fair List thereof.

VIII. Provided always, and be it Enacted, That before any Tobacco shall be delivered out of any Inspecting House, to be carried and conveyed to any Warehouse as aforesaid, the Person to whom the same shall be delivered, shall take an Oath or Affirmation if a Quaker, before the Inspector or Inspectors of such House, at which the same shall be delivered (who are hereby authorized and required to administer the same), " That he will with all Opportunity convey, or cause to be conveyed to the Warehouse Keeper or Keepers, at the Place at which the Tobacco to be sent by him shall be intended to be delivered, all Tobacco that shall be delivered to him to be carried to such Place, and the same will deliver to the Warehouse Keeper aforesaid. And that he will not take or suffer to be taken by any other Person whatever, any Tobacco out of any such Hogshead or Hogsheads, or other Casks or Cases, and that he will not wilfully The Person to whom delivered, to be Sworn: The Oath.
