

“ wilfully Damage or suffer to be Damaged such Tobacco, whilst the same shall remain under his Care or Management.” Of all which Deliveries of Tobacco in virtue of this Act, the Inspector or Inspectors respectively, shall and are hereby directed to keep a fair and distinct Account.

The Keepers to file their Lists, and keep Books, &c.

IX. And be it further Enacted, That the Keeper or Keepers of the said Warehouses, to be erected in virtue of this Act, shall, and they are hereby directed upon the Delivery to him or them, of any of the said Tobaccos in their respective Warehouses, which had been before delivered out of any Inspecting House, and upon the Delivery, also at the same Time of such List or Certificate as aforesaid, where by this Act such List or Certificate is directed to be given, receive and safe keep such Tobacco, and shall file such List or Certificate, give a Receipt for such Tobacco, and also enter the same in a Book to be provided and kept for that Purpose, expressing in such Receipt and Book, the Inspecting House from whence such Tobacco shall be brought, the Name of the Person by whom brought, the Name of the Proprietor, the Marks, Numbers, Gross, Tare, and Nett Weight of such Tobacco, and the Order or Condition of the Hoghead, Cask or Case, in which the same shall be contained. And shall also upon the Order or Request of the Proprietor of any Tobacco in his Custody, and Delivery up of the Receipt of such Warehouse Keeper or Keepers, deliver out such Tobacco, to any Skipper of a Boat, Flat or other Craft, to be Water-borne and safely carried on board any Ship or other Vessel, duly qualified to lade Tobacco for Exportation; such Warehouse Keeper or Keepers, at the same Time making and delivering to such Skipper, a List or Certificate in the Nature of an Inspectors List or Manifest, and such Skipper taking such Oath or Affirmation, for the safe keeping and delivery of such Tobacco on board the Ship or Vessel in which the same is designed to be exported, as Skippers of Flats, Sloops or other Vessels, are obliged to take before they receive Tobacco, by the Act, entitled, *An Act for amending the Staple of Tobacco, for preventing Frauds in his Majesty's Customs, and for the Limitation of Officers Fees*, which Oath or Affirmation, any one of the said Warehouse Keepers are hereby empowered, and every of them, respectively, shall administer.

Fee to be paid, for the Care of the Tobacco, &c.

X. Provided always, and be it Enacted, That before any Warehouse Keeper or Keepers, shall be obliged or compellable to deliver any Tobacco out of their respective Warehouses, to be erected in virtue of this Act, the Skipper of such Tobacco, shall, and is hereby obliged to pay to such Warehouse Keeper or Keepers, the Sum of for every Hoghead, Cask, or Case of Tobacco, then ordered or requested to be delivered for Exportation, as a Fee to such Warehouse Keeper or Keepers for his or their Trouble, in receiving, taking Care of, and delivering such Tobacco.
