To the Sheriff of *Dorchester County*, to elect a Delegate in the room of Mr. *Philemon Leconte*, deceased. And to the Sheriff of *Frederick County*, to elect Two Delegates in the room of Mr. *Joseph Chapline*, deceased, and Mr. *Thomas Jenings*, whose Seat is vacated.

ORDERED, That the Committee appointed to prepare an Address to the Governor, do also prepare and bring in an Address to Lord *Baltimore*, in Answer to his Message.

ORDERED, That Mr. *Ringgold*, Mr. *Dickinson*, Mr. *Worthington*, Mr. *Beall*, and Mr. *Willson*, be a Committee to inspect the Accounts and Proceedings of the Commissioners appointed by Virtue of the Act for the Payment of the public Claims, for emitting Bills of Credit, and for other Purposes therein mentioned.
