Your Committee have also examined the Conditions of said Bonds, and find them agreeable to the Act of Assembly made in the Year 1742, except the Conditions of Two Bonds, the one given by Benjamin Tasker, 17th January 1756, the other given by Daniel Dulary, 2d January 1759, which appear in the Words of the Act of 1716: Your Committee also observe, that the Penalties of said last mentioned Bonds, as also the Penalties of Two other Bonds, the one passed by Philip Thomas, 13th March 1743, the other by Daniel Dulany, 16th October 1742, are only 1000 Pounds, initead of 3000 Pounds current Money, but that the Conditions of the Two last mentioned Bonds are agreeable to the Act in 1742.
