A sufficient Number of Delegates to compose a House being convened at the House prepared by Mr. *John Frasier* for the Use of the Publick; Mr. *William Paca*, a Delegate returned for the City of Annapolis, and Mr. *Nicholas Thomas*, a Delegate returned for Talbot County, attended on his Excellency to acquaint him therewith.

Daniel of St. Thomas Jenifer and *George Plater*, Esqrs. of the Upper House, attended by *Dan Opaton Scott*, Clerk of the Upper House, came into the Lower House, and the aforesaid Delegates took the several Oaths to the Government required by Law, signed the Oath of Abjuration, repeated and signed the Test, in the Presence of the Two Gentlemen of the Upper House.

Daniel of St. Thomas Jenifer and *George Plater*, Esqrs. from the Upper House, acquainted the Members of this House, that the Governor requires the Attendance of the Members of the Lower House immediately in the Upper House.
