On Motion, ORDERED, That Leave be given to bring in a Bill to regulate attachments; and that Mr. Johnson, Mr. Chase, Mr. Wilson, Mr. J. Hall, Mr. Paca, Mr. So. Wright, and Mr. Thomas, do prepare and bring in the same.

On Motion, RESOLVED, That this House will, To-morrow Morning, take into Consideration the State of the Laws passed last Session of Assembly.

The House appoint Mr. Saint George Peale, Mr. Thomas Maddox, and Mr. Robert Wright, Clerks to the several Committees.

ORDERED, That they be qualified.
