June 13th 1776 Governor Robert Eden issued his Proclamation dissolving the General Assembly & ordering Writs for General Election returnable on 25th July 1776

June 25th 1776 The Convention then in Session being informed that the Proprietary has issued his proclamation aforesaid for the election of Delegates passed a resolution to this effect "Resolved" That the said Writs be not obeyed & that no election be made in consequence thereof"

"So terminated the Proprietary Government in Maryland & Governor Eden taking his departure from Annapolis in the Ship "Fowey"
