In the 15th line, firike out from the word, "to" to the word "without," in the 16th line, and infert, " execute the powers in them repoled by this act."

In the ift line of the 6th page, strike out "court-martial," and infert "field officer, with the

persons so directed to be called in."

In the 3d line of fixth page, strike out from the word " excused" to the end of the line. In the 4th line, strike out "all recruits," and insert "every recruit."

At the end of the 6th page, infert the following clauses:

" And be it enacted, That the several field officers before whom such draughts are made soull, under the penalty of one hundred pounds current money, make out the lifts of the draughts before them respectively made, and return the same to the lieutenants of the counties respectively

within five days after fuch draughts shall be made.

" And be it enasted, That the faid draughts and fubstitutes for nine months shall be sent to the American camp, in companies of at least fifty men, commanded by at least two commissioned of ficers, which commissioned officers shall be taken from among any officers who may be draughted in such manner as the lieutenants of the counties shall respectively direct. And if a sufficient number of commissioned officers proper for the purpose be not draughted, then the said lieuxenants shall respectively nominate a number sufficient for the purpose aforesaid, which officers to appointed shall be commissioned by the governor, paid by this state, and take charge of the faid draughts and substitutes, and conduct them to the American camp, and remain with their during the time for which the faid draughts and substitutes are continued in service; and that the go vernor and council be directed to request the commander in chief to appoint such officers from the regular battalions of this state to command the said draughts and substitutes, in conjunction with the officers with them sent, as to him shall seem proper.

" And be it enacted, That the faid officers, draughts and substitutes for nine months, shall be subject to the laws of this state, establishing rules and regulations for the militia of this state, when in actual fervice, in all instances, except that any officer in the regular battalions may fit in courts martial on the trial of any of the faid draughts and fubflitutes, and to no other rules or articles of war whatever, and that the faid draughts and fubflitutes shall not be turned into compa-

nies with the regular foldiers."

At the end of the 1st line of the 7th page, infert " unless excused as aforesaid."

After the word " court-martial," in 3d line, strike out to the word " officers" inclusive in 4th line, and infert " which faid court-martial shall be summoned by the lieutenant of the county to meet within five days from the time of issuing the summons for the meeting of the said court; and all the field officers of the county shall be summoned to attend; and the lieutenant, and any two or more of the faid field officers may compose the faid court."

In the 6th line, after the word "county," infert "and in fuch case the summons for the meeting of the faid court shall be issued by the oldest field officer of the county in manner and

form aforefaid."

In the 9th line, between "families" and "fhall," insert, "and are unable to pay."

At the end of the clause insert the following proviso:

" Provided always, That upon complaint made in the nature of an appeal, by any person who may think himself aggrieved by the judgment of such court-martial within twenty cays after the fame shall be given, the governor and council shall have full power and authority, in their difcretion, to mitigate or grant relief against such judgment."

Strike out from the beginning of the last clause in 7th page to the word "fined," in the 4th

line from the bottom, and infert as follow:

46 And be it enacted, That all such fines, when imposed, shall be paid to the county lieutenant or prefiding field officer of fuch court-martial, within twenty days after the same are imposed, and in case such fines shall not be so paid, the said court-martial, in all cases where there shall be no appeal from the sentence thereof, shall, twenty days after their adjudication and imposing of any fine and fines as aforesaid, transmit a copy of the sentence of the said court to the clerk of the county, who immediately after the receipt thereof shall issue a writ or writs of fieri facias against the goods, chattels, lands and tenements of the person or persons so fined, on which such proceedings shall and may be had as in other cases and judgments where writs of sieri facias are usually

466 And be it further enasted, That in case of an appeal to the governor and council, pursuant to the directions of this act, after the determination thereof, such writ or writs of fieri facias shall issue for the said fine and fines, or so much thereof as shall not be by them mitigated or released.

46 And be it further enacted, That in all such cases where a writ or writs of ficei facias shall isfue as aforesaid, in case the sheriff of the county shall return nulla bona thereon, it shall and may be lawful for the juffices of the county court, and they are hereby directed, to iffue a writ or writs of capias ad fatisfaciendum against the person or persons so fined as a oresaid, and thereupon fuch proceedings shall and may be had as in other cases where such writs are usually issued."

In the 6th line of 8th page, strike out "abovementioned," and insert "who have served as aforefaid." Ln
