On motion, the question was put, That any member of this house, who quits or resigns his seat in the same without leave, before the necessary business of the session is perfected, ought not to be considered as a true and steady friend to the independence of his country, and the common rights and liberties of mankind, and for such breach of trust and ignoble procedure, shall forfeit his whole preceding allowance? Determined in the negative.

On progression in reading the bill to raise the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-one, the question was put, That the blank for the price of transfer tobacco be filled up with "twelve shillings and six-pence?" The yeas and nays being called for by Mr. Kent, appeared as follow:
