No. 48. A Supplement to the act to raise the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and eighty one.

No. 49. An act to appoint commissioners to preserve confiscated British property.

No. 50. An act to secure disaffected persons.

No. 51. An act to procure a loan, and for the sale of escheat lands, and the confiscated British property therein mentioned.

No. 52. An act for the payment of the journal of accounts.

Mr. Speaker, with the members, returned and resumed the chair.

The house adjourns to the first day of May next.
