

Amendment proposed:— At the end of the bill insert the following clause: “ Provided, that nothing in this act shall be construed to affect the right of the said Ariana Kennedy, in case she shall survive the said Patrick Kennedy, or the right or rights of any other person or persons, by, from, or under the said Ariana Kennedy.”

Which was read and agreed to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

After the word “ recovered,” in the interlineation of the 8th line from the bottom, insert the following clause:

“ And be it enacted, That if there should not be a sufficient sum collected from the debts due to the said company to satisfy, in the first instance, his engagements as factor to the citizens of this or any of the United States, and to discharge his salary as agent or factor, and, in the second instance, all other creditors, in a just and equitable proportion, the said George Gray is hereby empowered to sell the houses and lots in Port-Tobacco-town, at public vendue, for the purposes aforesaid, after giving eight weeks notice in the Annapolis and Baltimore news-papers, on three years credit.”

In the 6th line from the bottom, strike out the word “ two” and insert “ five.”

After the word “ pay,” in the second line from the bottom, insert, “ after discharging the debts aforesaid.”
