That there is due on the western shore, for ordinary and marriage licences, and for fines and forseitures, the sum of 639 II 2; and on the eastern shore 95 4 2; but as no returns of fines and forseitures have been made for several counties, the sum due on both shores may amount to

That the money and bank notes in the treasury, and the intendant's iron cheft in the repository, amount to the sum of 61,412 9 5\frac{1}{4}. The special appropriations out of this money are, 8,260 15 0 for the redemption of red money, 1 3 10 to offi ers and soldiers ce tificates, 10 10 accounts, and 6,396 7 0 for the payment of interest on liquidated certificates under the act of May session 1781. After deducting the aforementioned sums, there will remain unappropriated the sum of 46 e16 11 11.
