

# VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS, NOVEMBER, 1785. 13

That there has been paid for interest since November last, under the act of May 1781, £. 7,563 13 11, and for interest on continental certificates liquidated £. 9,044 4 5, as may more fully appear by account of the monthly payments in paper No. 3.

That there are in both treasuries £. 37,522 12 5, of which are the following appropriations; to congress £. 7,000 0 0, to discharge claims against persons convicted of treason £. 482 19 0, for interest £. 1,341 19 8, and for the journal of accounts £. 302 3 5, there remains unappropriated the sum of £. 28,335 10 4.

That the caution money received on both shores amount to £. 4,404 7 10.

That the confiscated and forfeited property sold by the Intendant amount to the sum of £. 155,259 12 7, as by the account of sales and account current in book No. 8, and the treasurer's receipts, may appear, from which to be deducted Mrs. Dulany's thirds, expences of surveying, and the Intendant's commission, the sum of £. 6,188 9 7, the net balance £. 149,071 3, and included in the sum of £. 332,493 8 6.

From the foregoing premises the Intendant begs leave to make the following statement :
