On motion, Leave given to bring in an additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act for securing the title of the proprietors of lots and houses in Charles-town, in Charles county, passed November session, 1779. ORDERED, That Mr. Craik, Mr. Parnham and Mr. Dashiell, be a committee to prepare and bring in the same.

Mr. Parnham, from the committee, brings in and delivers to Mr. Speaker a bill, entitled, An act to regulate the inspection of tobacco; which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Amendments proposed. After the word "seize," in the 3d line of the same page, insert "for the use of the poor of the county." After the word "the," in the 5th line of the 6th page, insert the words "clerk of the market or the." After the word "pounds," in the 7th line of the sixth page, insert "current money." After the word "the," in the 8th line of the 6th page, insert the words "clerk of the market, or person or." After the word "part," in the 6th line from the bottom of the same page, insert "of such penalty."
