performance of the trust reposed in him by virtue of this act, and for truly accounting with the several persons interested in the collection of the said taxes, sees and charges; and the said bond shall

be recorded among the records of Kent county court, and be afterwards transmitted to the clerk of the general court for the eaftern shore, to be there recorded and deposited for safe custody.

"And provided also, That before the said Thomas Worrell, or his agents, shall proceed to collect, by execution, any taxes, tees or charges, claimed of any citizen or citizens of the said county, a full and fair account of such taxes, sees or charges, shall be delivered to every such citizen or a full and fair account of such cases, shall be delivered to every such citizen or a full and shall be enforced by the citizens, for the space of ten days at the least before a demand for payment shall be enforced by the faid collector or his agents; and every fuch account shall be verified by an ashdavit of the faid Thomas Worrell, if he be thereto required by any such citizen or citizens, that it does not appear by the books, papers, or other documents of Edward Worrell, late of Kent county, decealed, that the books, papers, or any article thereof, hath been paid or fatisfied, and that he doth not know of any said account, or any article thereof, hath been paid or fatisfied, and that he doth not know of any payment thereof being made to the faid Edward Worrell, or to any other person for his use, and that he hath not himself received the same, or any part thereof, except so much as shall be credited on the said account; and if any citizen, of whom such taxes, sees or charges, shall be claimed, shall allege that the same hath been paid to any agent or deputy of the said Edward Worrell, it shall be lawful for the faid Thomas Worlell, or other person interested, to cause such agent or deputy to be summoned before a justice of the peace of such county, and to be examined, on oath or assirmation, concerning the truth of fuch allegations."
