THE house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read. Mr. Jones, Mr. Ringgold, Mr. Mackall, and Mr. Clark, appeared in the house. Mr. Robert Amos, a delegate returned for Harford county, appeared, and after qualifying in the mode prescribed by the constitution and form of government, and taking the oath to support the constitution of the United States, took his seat in the house.

Mr. Smith, from the committee, brings in and delivers to Mr. Speaker a bill, entitled, A supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the inspection of salted provisions exported and imported from and to the town of Baltimore; which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.
