Page 8, strike out from the word "the" in the 1st line, to the word "and" in the second line, and insert in their room as follows, "first day of January, one thousand seven hundred and seventy-two." Page 8, line 2, after the word "three," insert "and on which patent is ready to be issued on application." Page 10, line 4, after the word "commissioners," insert "or a majority of them." Page 10, line 10, after the word "commissioners," insert "or a majority of them."
