

No. 38. An act to appoint commissioners to freighten and amend the roads therein mentioned, and for other purposes.

No. 39. An act for resurveying and laying out anew Salisbury-town, in Somerset county, and for other purposes.

No. 40. A Further supplement to an act, entitled, An act to freighten and amend the several public roads in the several counties, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

No. 41. An act to establish a public road from the main road leading from George-town into Still Pond Neck to the main road leading from the head of Churn creek to Worton, in Kent county.

No. 42. An additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act to remove the market-house at the Head of Elk, and establish the same, and for the advancement and regulation of the said town.

No. 43. An act to provide a summary mode of recovering the possession of lands and tenements holden by tenants for years, or at will, after the expiration of their terms.

No. 50. An act to settle and pay the civil list and other expences of civil government.

A Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to prevent the exportation of flour, staves and shingles, not merchantable, from the town of Baltimore, in Baltimore county, and to regulate the weight of hay and measure of grain, salt, flax-seed and fire wood, within the said town, and to prevent the exportation of flour, not merchantable, from Fell's Point, in the said county.

No. 54. An act to open and lay out roads from Denton, the seat of justice in Caroline county, to different parts of said county, and the same, when opened and laid out, to be the public roads of said county.

No. 56. An act to appoint a health officer for the port of Baltimore-town, in Baltimore county.

No. 57. An act respecting the punishment of criminals.

No. 58. A Further supplement to the act concerning the territory of Columbia and the city of Washington.

No. 59. An act for the establishment of a market for the sale of live stock, in or near to Baltimore-town.

No. 60. An act for the recovery of certain amerciaments, and also upon defaults on execution in criminal proceedings.

No. 61. An act to explain an act, entitled, An act for the valuation of real and personal property within this state, passed at November session, seventeen hundred and ninety-two.

No. 62. A Further supplement to the act respecting the settlers on the reserved lands westward of Fort Cumberland.

No. 63. An act for the benefit of John Hayman Nicholls.

No. 64. An act to authorize the chancellor to grant deeds and patents in certain cases.

No. 65. An act to repair the public roads in Queen-Anne's county.

No. 66. An act to provide for the appointment of commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Cambridge, in Dorchester county, and to establish and regulate a market in said town.

No. 67. A Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to freighten and amend the public roads in Harford county, and for other purposes.

No. 68. An act for the relief of sundry insolvent debtors.

No. 69. An act to erect Baltimore-town, in Baltimore county, into a city, and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof.

No. 70. A Further supplement to an act, entitled, An act for marking and bounding lands.
