- No. 77. A Supplement to the act, entitled, An act to establish a bank in the district of Columbia.
- No. 78. An act to relinquish the right of this state to the lands therein mentioned.
- No. 79. An act to authorise and empower the levy court of Montgomery county to assess and levy annually a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned.
- No. 80. An act to erect a new bridge over Great Choptank river, in Caroline county.
- No. 81. An act further extending the time for making returns of certain certificates and plots.
- No. 82. An act declaring the power of the governor in certain criminal cases.

- No. 85. An act directing returns to be made to the commissioners of the tax in the several counties of this state.

- No. 87. An act to appoint an agent for the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety-six.
- No. 88. An act relative to the proceedings in the court of chancery and in the land-office.
- No. 89. A Supplement to the act for enlarging the capital of this state in the Patowmack Company.
- No. 90. An act for the payment of the journal of accounts.
