GENTLEMEN,

WE have, without hesitation, passed the bill for the establishment of a hospital in or near the city of
Baltimore. As this institution is an object of great state importance, and extensively interesting to the
people of Maryland, we would submit to your consideration the propriety of contributing a larger
sum of money to so charitable a purpose. If the resolution passed at last session, appropriating eight
thousand dollars to the rebuilding of the academy in Baltimore that had been consumed by fire, can
with propriety be rescinded, we would recommend the application of that money, or some part thereof,
to this humane establishment, in addition to the sum given by your bill.
