Wilson, to consider and report thereon.

THE committee to whom was referred the petition of the directors of the Susquehanna River Company report, that they have taken the same into consideration, and are fully of opinion that the state of Maryland will derive immense wealth from rendering the said river navigable to tide water; the richest country within the United States must send its produce by that rout into the waters of Chesapeake, whenever the great work is accomplished; they therefore recommend the advance of money prayed for by the said company, upon bond being given by the directors thereof, that the monies so advanced shall be faithfully applied to the execution of the intended object.
