the 1st and 2d clauses: "And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of every person who shall impound any swine in virtue of this law, to cause the marks and description of such swine to be advertised in the George-town news-paper for at least seven days, and if the same are not reclaimed by that time, and the expences of advertising, impounding and keeping them, said, that the same shall be first applied to the expence of advertising, impounding and keeping them, and the same to the owner of said swine, if demanded within fixty days after the sale, and if not demanded within that time, then such surplus to be paid to the trustees of the poor house for Montagnery By order
