

VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS, November, 1798.

The report on the petition of Charles Mankin was read the second time, and the resolution therein contained dissented from.

The clerk of the senate delivers the engrossed bills No. 92, 93 and 97, with the paper bills thereof; which engrossed bills were thus endorsed; "By the senate, January 18, 1799: Read and assented to.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." The resolutions in favour of the trustee, clerk of the senate, members of the council, and William Kilty, severally endorsed; "By the senate, January 17, 1799: Read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

"By the senate, January 17, 1799: Read the second time by especial order and assented to. A. VAN-HORN, clk.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." The bill to prevent assignees from suing by bill of privilege or attachment of privilege, endorsed; "By the senate, January 15, 1799: Read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." "By the senate, January 17, 1799: Read the second time and will not pass.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." The supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the speedy recovery of small debts out of court, and to repeal the acts of assembly therein mentioned, endorsed; "By the senate, January 17, 1799: Read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." "By the senate, January 17, 1799: Read the second time by especial order and will not pass.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." The bill authorizing Nicholas Watkins, one of the collectors of Anne-Arundel county, to complete his collections, endorsed; "By the senate, January 14, 1799: Read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." "By the senate, January 18, 1799: Read the second time and will pass.

Ordered to be engrossed. A. VAN-HORN, clk.

And the bill to authorize an exchange of lands between John Eversfield and the other representatives of Matthew Eversfield, late of Prince-George's county, endorsed; "By the senate, January 12, 1799: Read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." "By the senate, January 17, 1799: Read the second time and will pass with the proposed amendments.

"By order, A. VAN-HORN, clk." Which amendments were read the first and second time, agreed to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

The paper bills No. 92, 93 and 97, were sent to the senate by the clerk.

On motion, the question was put, That the house reconsider the bill for the promotion of literature in this state? Resolved in the affirmative.
