A petition from sundry inhabitants of Washington-county, praying an act may pass appointing commissioners to correct a mistake made in laying out and straightening the road from Elizabeth-town by colonel Stull's mill to the South Mountain on the way to Frederick-town, was preferred, read, and referred to Mr. Tilghman, Mr. Ott and Mr. Smith, to consider and report thereon.

Mr. M'Pherson, from the committee of claims, delivers to the speaker the following report:

BY THE COMMITTEE OF CLAIMS.

YOUR committee beg leave to report, that they have examined the accounts and proceedings of Thomas Harwood, Esquire, treasurer of the western shore, and find, by an account settled by the committee of claims to the first day of November, 1800, there was a balance of 104,504 dollars 14 cents funded 6 per cent. stock, 258,979 dollars 47 cents funded 3 per cent. stock, 75,879 dollars 78 cents deferred 6 per cent. stock, and the sum of £ 7759 7 0½ specie, remaining in the treasury.

That it appears to your committee, by the accounts of the said treasurer, he hath received, for escheats, caution, and improvements on land certificates, £ 3083 9 1¼ specie. For taxes under the act for establishing and securing the salary to the chancellor, £ 830 3 8 specie. For bonds taken for money loaned £ 1233 13 9 specie. For bonds taken for vacant land in Allegany county £ 236 4 5 specie. From William Marbury, for a balance due from him on the auditor's books, £ 4433 13 8 specie. From Benjamin Harwood, trustee, for dividends of interest and principal on stock, £ 7832 2 4 specie. And from the bank of Baltimore, on loan, the sum of £ 11137 10 0 specie.

That it appears to your committee the said treasurer hath received from the agent of the state, for confiscated property, 507 dollars 75 cents funded 6 per cent. stock, 1702 dollars 99 cents deferred 6 per cent. stock, and £ 1819 3 0 specie. For taxes, 6883 dollars 31 cents funded 6 per cent. stock, 315 dollars deferred 6 per cent. stock, and £ 1347 15 0 specie. For bonds taken for the emissions of 1769 and 1773, 817 dollars 35 cents funded 6 per cent. stock, and £ 293 15 8 specie. For bonds taken for money and stock loaned £ 3857 9 0 specie. For bonds taken for open accounts and specifics sold £ 129 7 0½ specie. For bonds taken for vacant land in Allegany county £ 1200 11 9 specie. For bonds taken for Indian lands £ 3519 7 1 specie. For negroes banished, and sold for the benefit of the state, £ 243 7 7½ specie. For fines, forfeitures and amerciaments, £ 2962 5 10 specie. For marriage licences £ 1734 0 0 specie. For ordinary, retailers, hawkers and pedlers licences, £ 4543 8 10½ specie. For taxes under the act for the better administration of justice £ 1837 8 7½ specie. And from the treasurer of the eastern shore £ 2613 9 6 specie.

That it appears to your committee, by the accounts of the said treasurer, he hath paid away, from the first day of November, 1800, to the first day of November, 1801, the sum of 239 dollars 78 cents funded 6 per cent. stock, 119 dollars 86 cents deferred 6 per cent. stock, 179 dollars 78 cents funded 3 per cent. stock, and the sum of £ 45983 1 1¼ specie. For all which payments have been produced to your committee the necessary vouchers and receipts; and that there remains in the treasury the sum of 109,102 dollars 50 cents funded 6 per cent. stock, 77,777 dollars 91 cents deferred 6 per cent. stock, 258,799 dollars 69 cents funded 3 per cent. stock, and the sum of £ 16,664 11 10½ specie, which sum of specie is appropriated in the manner following, viz.
