to the treasurer, the sum of £ 11320 10 11½, amounting to the sum of £ 12150 14 7½, as per abstracts number 2 and 5. On account of money and stock loaned, for bonds taken for open accounts, and for open accounts and specifics, by the treasurer, the sum of £ 1233 13 9, and by the agent, and paid to the treasurer, the sum of £ 3986 16 0½, amounting to the sum of £ 5220 9 9½, as per abstracts number 3 and 6. On account of taxes on the western shore, by the agent, and paid to the treasurer, the sum of £ 4047 2 3, as per abstract number 7. On account of the emissions of 1769 and 1773, by the agent, and paid to the treasurer, the sum of £ 600 5 10, as per abstract number 8. On account of fines, forfeitures, marriage, ordinary, retailers, hawkers, and pedlers licences, &c. on the eastern shore, by the agent, and paid to the treasurer, the sum of £ 4086 1 1, as per abstract number 9. On account of fundries, on the western shore, by the treasurer, the sum of £ 26486 15 1¼, and by the agent, and paid to the treasurer, the sum of £ 2613 9 6, amounting to the sum of £ 29100 4 7¾, as per abstract number 10. That there have been bonds taken in virtue of the act appointing an agent for the year 1801, to the amount of £ 733 19 4, all of which have been deposited in the treasury of the western shore, as per abstract number 11. Number 12 contains an estimate of the agent's commission on the amount of receipts from the first day of January, 1801, to the first day of November, 1801.

From which several statements, the aggregate receipts on both shores, from the first of November, 1800, to the first day of November, 1801, amount to the sum of £ 62809 5 0½, and bonds taken to the amount of £ 733 19 4.
