- No. 23. An act to incorporate a company for building bridges over the Great Falls and the Little Falls of Gunpowder, in Baltimore county, and Winter's run, in Harford county.
- No. 24. An act for the relief of the representatives of Nicholas Merryman, late of Baltimore county, deceased.
- No. 25. An act to alter and change the names of Mary Smock, Robert Smock, John Smock and Anne Smock, of the city of Baltimore, into the name of Nesbit.
- No. 26. An act to extend the powers of the levy court of Allegany county relative to roads in said county.
- No. 27. An act authorising a lottery to raise a sum of money for improving the navigation of the eastern branch of Patowmack river.
- No. 28. A Further supplement to an act to streighten and amend the public roads in Harford county, and to repeal the act of assembly therein mentioned.
- No. 29. A Further supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the draining of a marsh and branch, known by the name of the Long Marsh, lying in Queen-Anne's and Caroline counties.
- No. 30. An act to authorise the levy court of Saint-Mary's county to levy a sum of money for the rent of a clerk's office.
- No. 31. An act to authorise the levy court of Harford county to assess and levy a sum of money for the purposes therein mentioned.

- No. 36. A Further supplement to an act, entitled, An act to authorise and empower the levy court of Montgomery county to assess and levy a sum of money on the assessable property thereof for the purpose of building a new gaol in said county.
