

on or before the — day of November, make a just and accurate report of all and every such sums of money drawn as aforesaid, with the appropriations of the same, accompanied with such vouchers as will satisfactorily exhibit the specific applications thereof.

XLV. **And be it enacted,** That the inspectors aforesaid shall have full power and authority to provide necessaries for every description of persons who may be confined in said gaol, and to separate and class the different prisoners in such manner as they shall judge will best promote the object of their confinement.

XLVI. **And be it enacted,** That if the keeper or gaoler, or other person whatsoever, shall introduce into, or give away, barter or sell within, the gaol and penitentiary-house aforesaid, or in the area or yard thereof, any spirituous or fermented liquors, excepting only such as the gaoler or keeper thereof shall make use of in his own family, or such as may be required for any prisoner in a state of ill health, and for such purpose prescribed by the attending physician, and delivered into the hands of such physician, or other person appointed to receive the same, such person shall forfeit and pay the sum of — dollars, to be recovered as debts of like value may be recovered by the laws of this state, one moiety thereof to the use of the person suing, the other moiety to be paid to the said inspectors, to be by them applied towards defraying the current expences of said gaol.

XLVII. **And be it enacted,** That said keeper or gaoler of the gaol and penitentiary-house, his deputies and assistants, in case any of the offenders therein shall escape from confinement without the knowledge or consent of the said keeper, deputies or assistants, shall forfeit and pay the sum of — dollars, to be recovered and applied in manner last aforesaid; and if any such offender shall escape from his or her confinement in said gaol with the knowledge or approbation of said keeper, his deputies or assistants, the said keeper, or his deputies or assistants, as the case may be, shall, on conviction thereof before the criminal court of Baltimore city, be fined in any sum, at the discretion of said court, not exceeding — dollars for each and every such offence, to be applied as aforesaid.
