

The house proceeded to the second reading of the bill to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county, and for other purposes, and on progression in reading said bill, the question was put, That the words "the three following companies" be struck out the following clause in said bill? to wit: "Be it enacted, by the general assembly of Maryland, that the three following companies shall be incorporated, to wit: One for making a turnpike road from the city of Baltimore to Frederick-town, and from thence to Middletown, and from thence to Boonsborough; one for making a turnpike road from Baltimore through Reister's-town towards Hanover-town; and one other company for making a turnpike road from Baltimore towards York-town to the Pennsylvania line."
