creek, in Washington county, to the Pennsylvania line, the bill to authorise a lottery to raise a sum of money for building a wharf at the town of Cambridge, in Dorchester county, and the bill to erect a town in Montgomery county, and for other purposes, severally endorsed, "will pass." Ordered to be engrossed. The bill authorising Philemon C. Blake, late sheriff of Queen-Anne's county, to complete his collection, endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment;" which amendment was read, agreed to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed. And a bill, entitled, An act to authorise and empower the president, managers and company, of the Baltimore and Frederick-town turnpike road, to collect tolls on the bridge erected over the river Monocacy; which was read, and ordered to have a second reading on Tuesday next.

On the second reading of the resolution appointing commissioners to review a road in Baltimore and Harford counties, on motion by Mr. Randall, the question was put, That the words "commencing so as to intersect the public road leading from Slade's tavern to the upper cross road," be stricken out of the same, for the purpose of inserting the words "at a public road at or near Thomas Hope's?" Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. Archer, the question was put, That the following be added to the said resolution? to wit: "Resolved, That the petitioners for the road pay unto the said commissioners the sum of two dollars for each and every day they shall be occupied in complying with the terms of the foregoing resolution." Determined in the negative.

The question was then put, That the house assent to the resolution? Resolved in the affirmative.

The house proceeded to the second reading of the bill to tax bank stock for the establishment of schools, and on motion by Mr. Archer, the question was put, That the words "for the establishment and support of schools," be stricken out of the title? The yeas and nays being required, appeared as follow:
