 Mr. M. Brown delivers a petition from Jonathan Parish and Robert Davis, of Baltimore county, praying that the state may relinquish its interest in and to the real estate of William Mahn, deceased; which was read and referred to Mr. M. Brown, Mr. Randall and Mr. Harryman.
