Bills of the following titles, were this day severally reported,
 By Mr. Fitzhugh, from the committee on the militia. A further supplement to the act, entitled, An act to regulate and discipline the militia of this state.

By Mr. Potter, from the committee on ways and means, An act to abolish all that part of the constitution and form of government, which requires the appointment of a treasurer on the eastern shore. And,

An act to abolish all that part of the constitution and form of government, which requires the appointment of a register of the land office on the eastern shore,

By Mr. Potter, from a select committee, An act to tax all travelling show-men, players, slight-of-hand-men, ventriloquists, and jugglers, in this state.

By Mr. Stewart, of Anne-Arundel, An act to protect the breed of oysters, in the waters of Anne-Arundel county. And,

By Mr. Gantt, An act to make valid a certain deed therein mentioned, and for other purposes.

Which said bills were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

On motion by Mr. Steuart of Baltimore, the house proceeded to consider the resolution, reported by him on the 26th instant, in favour of the securities of Robert H. Scharf, late collector of the state tax, and of the county rate and assessment, of Baltimore county, and the same being read the second time,
