

port, that they have carefully examined and compared the engrossed bills of the house of delegates, designated from number ninety-four, to number one hundred and sixty-three, both inclusive, also from number one hundred and eighty one, to number two hundred and four, both inclusive, and from number two hundred and fifteen, to number two hundred and eighteen, both inclusive; also the engrossed bills of the senate, designated from number one hundred and sixty four, to number one hundred and eighty, both inclusive, and from number two hundred and five, to number two hundred and fourteen, both inclusive, also the engrossed resolutions of this house, designated from number one, to number eighteen, both inclusive, also from number twenty, to number seventy-nine, both inclusive, and from number eighty one, to number eighty four, both inclusive; and also the engrossed resolutions of the senate, designated by the numbers nineteen, eighty, and eighty-five, with the originals thereof, as heretofore passed by both branches of the legislature, and that they have found the same to be truly engrossed.
